## Annual Spring Work Day and Vaccination Clinic

On Saturday, May 3rd RBR will hold its Semi-Annual Work Day and Vaccination Clinic. We'll begin our work day at 8:00 am in the Clubhouse with fresh coffee compliments of Fly Manglicmot of The Coffee Gallery in Altadena and plenty of healthy snacks to get you going! John Hedrick, our Dir. of Grounds will have several projects, big and small, for us to work on. We'll stop around 1:00 pm to have lunch in the picnic area compliments of RBR. It's a good idea to bring gloves and some tools if you can. Remember to label anything you bring to ensure that you'll get it back! If you can't make the work day you may either send a donation to the P.O. Box or ask John for a job to do on your own time.

The Vet Clinic with Dr. Peralez will begin at 8:00 am by the Main Barn. RBR requires all horses boarded to be up to date on vaccinations *and* de-worming. Please be sure to sign your horse up by April 28th for the appropriate shots (Sign-up sheet will be posted next week). Most horses will be due for Flu/Rhino, 3-way *and* West Nile but if you are not sure which shots your horse is due for, call the office at (626) 446-8911 and check. Remember to bring your checkbooks! If you cannot attend please let me know so that I can be sure your horse gets the attention it needs. If your horse is on a different vaccination schedule, please let me know as well for our records.

## Art Classes to be Taught

Many RBR members are artists and educators, and RBR has a long tradition of hosting groups of children for art classes. Beginning in Spring 2008, in cooperation with the City of Pasadena Human Services and Recreation Dept, two new and exciting classes will be offered by artist, teacher, and equestrian Patty Sue Jones.
