### Reminders:

- o Remember to clean up your manure after using the arenas. When Vitalio turns your horse out, it is not his responsibility to pick up after them. Please pick up a few piles the next time you're at RBR, *even* if they're not yours!
- o Water buckets need to be cleaned and refilled *at least* every 3 days to prevent mosquito breeding.
- o **As of July 1, Boarding fees will be \$175 (\$95 stall fee + \$80 feed fee).**
