Vaccination Clinic and Work Day

-On Saturday, October 28th, RBR will be holding its Semi-Annual Work Day and Vaccination Clinic. We will begin our work day promptly at 8:00 am in the Clubhouse with fresh coffee compliments of Fly Manglicmot of The Coffee Gallery in Altadena and plenty of healthy snacks to get you going! Susie Brown, our Dir. Of Grounds will have several projects for us to work on, including planting donated natives and setting up our new storage sheds. We'll stop around 1:00 pm to have lunch in the picnic area compliments of RBR! It's a good idea to bring gloves and some tools if you can. Remember to label anything you bring to ensure that you'll get it back!

- o **If you cannot make the work day you may either send a donation (be sure to note "Work Day Donation" in the memo of your check) to the P.O. Box or ask Susie for an alternate job to be done within the following month.**

-The Vet Clinic with Dr. Peralez will begin at 8:30 am by the Main Barn and continue until about 11:00 am. RBR requires all horses boarded to be up to date on vaccinations *and* de-worming. Please be sure to sign your horse up by October 24th for the appropriate shots (Sign-up sheet is posted above the phone). Most horses are only due for their Flu/Rhino and West Nile vaccines. If you are not sure which shots your horse is due for, call Dr. Peralez's office at (626) 446-8911 to check. Remember to bring your checkbooks! If you cannot attend please let me know so that I can be sure your horse gets the attention it needs. You may either give your checks to me to give to Dr. Peralez or mail it in advance to his office. If your horse is on a different vaccination schedule, please let me know as well.

Horsemanship 101 Class

For the past four Sundays instructor Alexis Young has led a large group of enthusiastic children through the RBR grounds and given them a well rounded equine education. Over the session students learned how to feed, care for, groom and lead a horse as well as different types of tack. On the last date they were even able to put their newfound knowledge to the test and go on a short ride to practice their skills!
