Work Day & Vet Clinic

On Saturday May 7th We will be holding our our semi-annual work day and vet clinic. You may either give your checks to me to give to Dr. Peralez or mail it in advance to his office. If your horse is on a different vaccination schedule, please let me know as well.

This year Dr. Peralez is offering both intranasal and intramuscular vaccines, please choose one on the sign up sheet. For pros/cons on either one, call Dr. Peralez.
