Work Day & Vaccination Clinic

On Saturday November 5th we will be holding our semi-annual work day and vaccination clinic. We will begin our work day promptly at 8am in the Clubhouse with fresh coffee compliments of the Coffee Gallery in Altadena and plenty of healthy snacks to get you going! Susie Brown, our Dir. Of Grounds will have several projects for us to work on! We'll stop around 1pm and have lunch in the picnic area. It's a good idea to bring gloves and some tools if you can. Remember to label anything you bring to ensure that you'll get it back! If you cannot make the work day, you may either send a donation to the P.O. Box or ask Susie for an alternate job.

The Vaccination Clinic with Dr. Peralez will begin at 9:30am by the main Mare Motel and continue until about 12pm. RBR requires all horses boarded to be up to date on vaccinations *and* de-worming. Please be sure to sign your horse up by November 1st for the appropriate shots (Sign up sheet on bulletin Board above phone). If you are not sure which shots your horse is due for, call the office at (626) 446-8911 and check. Remember to bring your checkbooks! I will make a list of all the horses Dr. Peralez notes are due for sheath and/or teeth cleaning and schedule a follow-up appointment. I will call you as well as post the info. on the Calendar as to when your horse's appointment is. If you cannot attend, please let me know so that I can be sure your horse gets the attention it needs. You may either give your checks to me to give to Dr. Peralez or mail it in advance to his office. If your horse is on a different vaccination schedule, please let me know as well.

Arenas

On Tuesday and Friday mornings Tim will drag the main and jumping arenas IF the sprinklers are out and there are only 3 or less jumps in the jumping arena. If the dressage court is up in the main arena, move the poles from sides A and C and lay them parallel with the long sides so he can drag inside. Please take the time to help water the arenas when you're at the barn, especially on the days before it gets dragged.

Sand for Stalls

I will be arranging for washed concrete sand to come in early November. Prices are \$155 for 8 tons (full stall) and \$77.50 for 4 tons (half stall). Sign up in the Mare Motel by October 14th to ensure your order. Checks may be made out to "Donaldson Trucking". You may either hire Vitalio to put the sand in your stall or do it yourself. Vitalio charges \$70 for a full stall and \$35 for a half. Please pay him promptly. If you plan to put the sand in yourself, it must be done within a week of the delivery.
