CANCELLATION POLICY:

If a rider cancels before the final due date, you may receive a refund, minus the non-refundable deposit. After the final due date, fees are non-refundable, but may be transferred to another qualified rider approved by the instructor. Any exception to this policy will be considered on a case-by-case basis for extreme emergencies only. Auditor fees are non-refundable but transferable.

PLEASE NOTE: Minimum of 6 students required to retain above format. If the event is not filled by final payment due date, there may be a change in format, or it may be cancelled or postponed to a later date. In the event of cancellation or postponement, fees paid are fully refundable or transferable, student's choice.

RIDER/HORSE GUIDELINES:

Ground skills clinics are suitable for horses of any age past weaning. However, do not bring a mare with a foal or a stallion. For riding clinics, a rider should use a horse they can comfortably walk and trot on for Level 1/Beginning Level 2; walk, trot and canter on in upper Level classes. Please do not bring an unriden horse, a horse that has not been ridden for a very long time, a stallion, or a horse that is not in good physical condition. Individual situations vary, so please pass on any special requests to the Clinic Coordinator for consultation with the Instructor. **Please notify Instructor of any physical limitations you or your horse have in the space below.**

Young, unriden horses may be used in the non-riding portions at all Clinics consistent with their level, if a space is available, with permission of the Instructor. Another horse cannot be used for the riding portion only. Preference is given for horse/rider combinations that can participate fully in the Clinic.

Those under the age of 18 must have prior approval from the Instructor to participate in a Clinic. A parent must be present at all times. Legal guardians are accepted with proper documentation.

Do not change horses or riders during the Clinic. If a rider or horse becomes unable to complete the Clinic, no refund will be given as the Clinic host or Instructor cannot be responsible for unforeseen events.

Advancing Level 1 Clinics and above have prerequisites. If you are riding in one of these levels and you are unclear what these requirements are, please contact the Clinic Coordinator.

HORSE EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Ground Skills – Level 1: Halter and lead. PNH equipment preferred (Parelli Horseman’s halter, 12-foot line, carrot stick and six-foot savvy string), but not required. The Parelli Partnership Program (Level 1) and/or Natural Horsemanship Book will facilitate your success in PNH classes. **Riding Skills – Level 1:** Halter, 12-foot line, and saddle of your choice. **Level 2/3:** All PNH equipment appropriate to your level and saddle of your choice**

** Some Parelli equipment and educational materials may be available for purchase at the Clinic.
